
"Sky Song" by Nick Geurts and Ryan Elmendorf. Installed in 2017 at the Levitt Pavillion at Ruby Hill Park.



Sky Song is an interactive art installation designed and fabricated by Denver-based artists Nick Geurts and Ryan Elmendorf. The mirror-polished stainless steel 8-foot structure invites passersby to press any combination of its 33 buttons which will activate lights and bell sounds on the corresponding stainless-steel piece on the amphitheater building façade. The sound can be turned off when there's a concert in the amphitheater. The Levitt pavilion offers 50 free concerts a year!
